Today's activities are:

Maths and English activities will be covered in class by children at school



1. **English:** now we have looked at all the sounds you can play one or more of the games below or create your own game to play with the sounds:

Phonics

-Bingo! Have you and your grown up split a piece of paper into 6. Both of you choose different sounds from the sheet on the website and write one into each of your boxes. Write all the sounds onto a small piece of paper (one for each sound) and put them into a hat. Take it in turns to pick a sound from the hat. Have you got it on your board? Circle it if you do. Say Bingo! when you have circled all of your sounds.

-4 in a row – print or write out the sound grid. Get your grown up to say a word to you with one of the sounds (saying where the sound is: start, middle, end) e.g. the middle sound in book or end sound in fur. Tell the grown up what the sound is then find it on your grid and colour it in. Can you get 4 coloured in a row?

-Sound hunt – find something of each sound and draw a picture of it next to each sound.

2. **Maths:** today you are being creative with cylinders. You might like to use a cardboard tube you have at home, create your own using paper or print out an example to create from the website. You could make an animal,



someone in your family, a friend, your favourite character, or a whole set of characters. The possibilities are endless!
