


<p>Today's activities are: <b>Maths and English activities will be covered in class by children at school</b></p>	<p>✓</p>
<p>1. <b>English:</b> Watch BBC bitesize the er sound: <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zvq9bdm/articles/zvmnmfr">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zvq9bdm/articles/zvmnmfr</a> Which words had the er sound in them? Can you think of any more from your hunts around the house? Look at the pictures on the page. What is the first picture of? There are two words underneath the picture. Carefully sound them out and blend them together. Circle (or point) to the word that matches the picture above. Extension: choose a couple of the er words and put these into a sentence. Can you write a sentence using two of the er words?</p>	
<p>2. <b>Maths:</b> Today we are looking at doubling. Remember that when you double something you have two of them. You could use your fingers to help you if a grown up say double one, put one finger up on one hand. How many do you need on the other hand? Now try two fingers. How many do you need to add to the other hand to double the number? Look at the first domino. How many dots does it have? Add the same number of dots to the other side of the domino to double the number. Add up all the dots to find the double answer and write it on the line below. If you cannot print out the sheet you can draw some dominoes of your own on a piece of paper or use some beads, pieces of Lego etc... to help you work out the answers. Extension: move onto the second domino page that has doubles up to 20. Remember to add the same number of spots to the other side and add them altogether to find the double. If you have some dominoes at home you could see how many doubles there are inside.</p>
