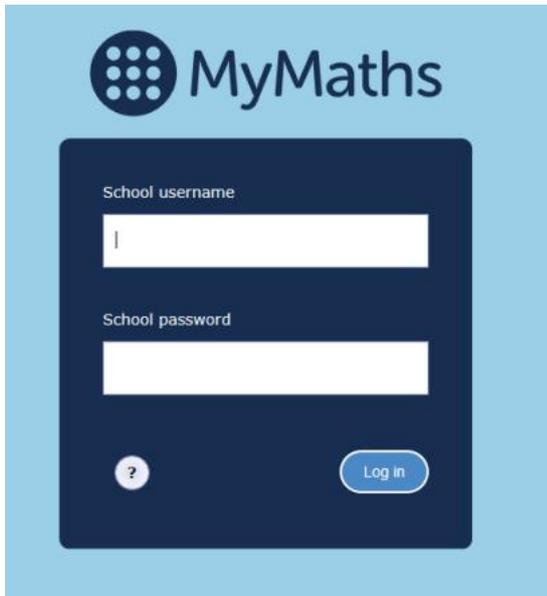


## Guide to using MyMaths

You may find that MyMaths does not work for Google Chrome, you may need to switch browsers to Edge.

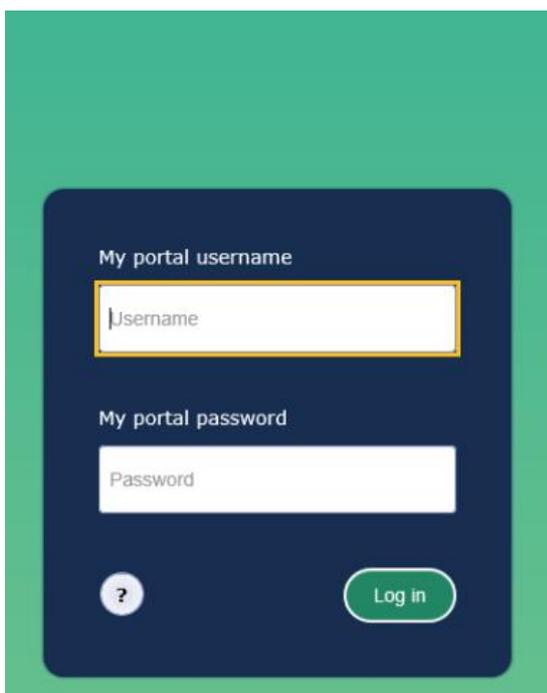
**In order to sign in** visit: <https://login.mymaths.co.uk/>

You then need to type in the **school username: eshercs** and **password: symmetry**

### MyMaths feedback

If you want to see how well you have done in your mymaths work, then click on the purple scores tab. See picture below.



If you want to see the comment that we have left you on your completed work, or want to try again, then simply click on the task. (see example below)



When you click on the task a window will come up showing your score, an option to have another go if you are unhappy with your score and at the bottom of the window, you will find a comment from your teacher.
