Hello everyone! We hope you have a fabulous day doing your remote learning. We are so excited to see you all this morning for a Welcome Back call on Teams.

Our word of the day is: **concocting**- This means to make to create something. For example, Miss Leach and Mrs Cotter like concocting different meals.

<p>Today's activities are:</p>	
<p>1. Maths: Multiplication and Division- Arrays</p> <p>We are going to continue to explore how we can use arrays to solve multiplication and division problems. Today's questions might have more than one answer so they will take a bit of thinking time. See if you can find more than one way of sharing the numbers equally. Your knowledge of your times tables might help you too.</p> <p><b>Activities:</b> We would like you to have a go at the discussion problems we have uploaded for you about sharing equally. To solve the problems, you could draw arrays (of cookies) to make sure the numbers are shared equally.</p> <p><i>Tricky to draw the arrays?</i> A top tip is to use objects for your arrays as you can move them around e.g. pasta shapes.</p>	
<p>2. English: <b>SPaG</b>: - Punctuation</p> <p>Today we would like you to use what you remembered yesterday and recap where different punctuation goes in the different types of sentences. Remember you could use a full stop and question mark or an exclamation mark depending on what the sentence type is (you could use the poster we posted yesterday). We have some really fun writing activities coming up and would love to see some lovely punctuation in them...today will help!</p> <p><b>Activities:</b> Answer the questions on the mild, hot and spicy sheets. We would like you to do the mild sheet and have a go at the hot sheet. If you are feeling super confident, try the spicy as an extension. If you are unable to print them off, write down your answers on a piece of paper. You can mark your work yourself using the answer sheet.</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> Please read for 10 minutes today and talk about your reading with a grown up.</p> <p><b>Phonics:</b> Focus sound of the day is: <b>ai</b>. Can you be a word sorter? Look at the words with the 'ai' phoneme. Can you sort them into the correct graphemes? If you are unable to print out the sheet, write the words down under the correct 'ai' grapheme. Do you know any other words that have the 'ai' grapheme? Can you add them to the list?</p> <p><b>Handwriting:</b> We are going to be recapping the <b>ir</b> and <b>er</b> joins today: Practise writing the joins neatly.</p> <p><i>ir, er,</i></p>	

Write out the words from the word bank below three times each.

Word bank: her, expert, iceberg, performance, dirtier, birthday, thirteenth
