Question Time – use your imagination to write creatively. What is the significance of the clock tower? Is there someone inside? What does 'the fateful hour' mean? What is it that the crowd are waiting for? What does the word 'expectant' tell you about how the crowd are feeling? What will happen when 'the fateful hour' arrives? Why does only one person carry a red umbrella?	
<b><u>Reading</u></b> : Read for at least 30 minutes. Include at least 5 minutes aloud to a member of your family. <b>Spelling</b> : Go to Spellzone and complete the activities set for you there.
