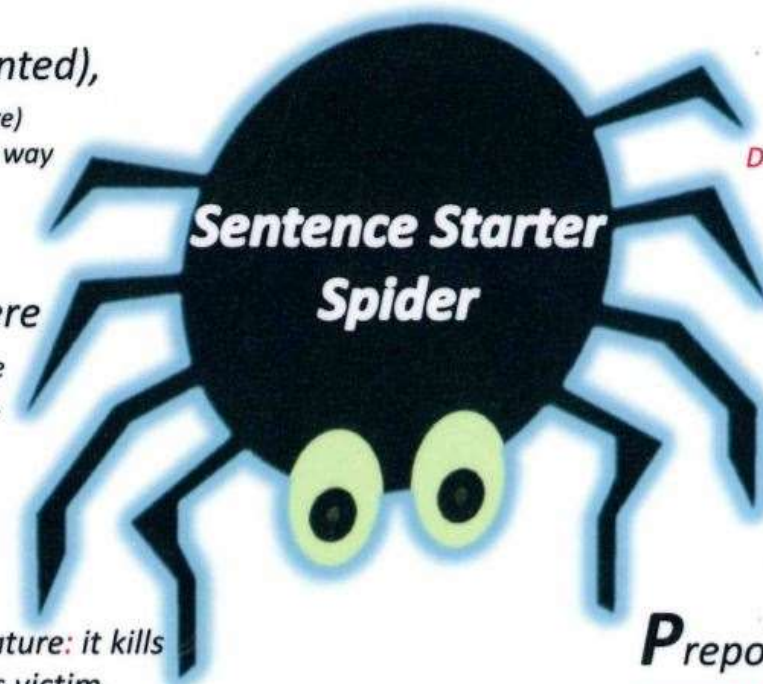


**A**dverbial (fronted),

**P**reposition  
*Beneath her feet*, the leaves crunched  
loudly.
