<b>Maths</b> <b>L1: To identify the place value and order of numbers.</b>  Today we have set two activities on MyMaths for you. The first activity is called <b>HTO place value</b> and is about the place value of 3-digit numbers. The second activity is called <b>Ordering whole numbers</b> which includes 2-digit numbers and 3-digit numbers. <b>English</b> <b>L1: To listen to a story and answer questions.</b>  This half-term we will be reading the book <b>Stone Age Boy</b> by Satoshi Kitamura which links with our Big Enquiry about the Stone Age.  It is about a curious boy wandering in the woods one day, when he falls down, down, down. When he wakes up, he finds he is completely lost and has been transported back in time. He walks and walks and finally finds a strange girl, called Om. She welcomes him into her clan and teaches him	

how to hunt, make tools, use animal skins and prepare and cook food . One day, when exploring a dark cave, the two friends come face to face with a terrifying bear. Will they escape?

**Themes** - Time travel, archaeology, destiny, the Stone Age.
