5. Write a paragraph of your character description using your chosen expanded noun phrases and turn them into complete sentences.
6. Remember to use capital letters, full stops and joined handwriting.

RE

Our RE this half-term is to reflect on the question '**Why should we care for God's world?**'

LI: To think about how special planet Earth is and to describe what is precious.

Think about special places in the natural world you like. It could be a garden, a place you like to walk or cycle or a place you have visited on holiday. What makes it special for you?
