Protect our plants and seeds by creating a scarecrow out of recycled materials

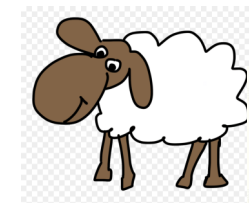


Expert knowledge:

Reading:

Introduce digraphs/trigraphs: oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.

Blending words with digraphs and trigraphs

Reading words with double letters, longer words, words with 2 or more digraphs, words ending in ing, compound words, words with s/z/ in the middle, words with—/s /z/ at the end

Reading individual books focused on phonics. Words with—es, /z/ at the end

Writing:

One-armed Robot and Zig Zag Monster letter family focus.

Segmenting for spelling words with digraphs and trigraphs.

Spelling non decodable words (ECCB words).

Understanding the world:

- Learning about our environment: reduce, reuse, recycle
- Planting seeds and caring for them
- Experimenting with sinking and floating
- Observe and record different signs of spring
- Compare living in Esher to living in the country side.
- Learn how to use simple software to direct a caterpillar
