

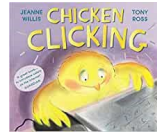

How can I make my garden grow?

Expert knowledge:

- Photosynthesis is the process where plants make their own food
- Germination is when plants begin to grow
- Deciduous trees lose all of their leaves in autumn
- Evergreen trees keep their leaves all year
- Pontius Pilate agreed to release Barabbas (a murderer) and sentenced Jesus to death
- Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane before he was arrested
- Judas Iscariot was the disciple who betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver
- Simon Peter denied knowing Jesus three times once Jesus was arrested

English:

- Analyse a range of poems identifying its features and then creating own examples
- To plan, write, edit and publish a poem using poetic devices
- Explore a range of non fiction texts that are structured in different ways
- Write a non-fiction text
- Use adverbs to add information to sentences
- Use commas to separate items in a list
- Writing non-fiction text using the correct tense

Science:

- Measure my body parts to see if I have grown and to record this
- Identify the different parts of a plant
- Identify the life cycle of a plant
- Explain pollination by identifying the different parts of a flower
- Discover what seeds need to germinate
- Identify common, wild and garden plants
- Discover what is in a seed
- Identify common trees and describe the difference between deciduous and evergreen
- Explain how plants adapt in different habitats

D & T:

- Understand where fruit comes from
- Explore and evaluate a wide range of fruits
- Make a sustainable fruit salad

PE:

- To learn some stretches to help me manage my feelings
- Learn to use breathing as a way to relax
- To send the ball with some accuracy to maintain possession and build attacking play
- To work as a team and show encouragement and communication

How can I make my garden grow?

Maths:

- Number and place value, fractions
- Recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity
- Recognise equivalence of $\frac{1}{2}$
- Money , temperature
- Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure temperature ($^{\circ}\text{C}$) to the nearest appropriate unit, using thermometers.
- Solving problems using multiplication and division using materials, arrays, repeated addition, mental methods, and multiplication and division facts, including problems in context
- Tell and write the time to five minutes

Computing:

- Search and retrieve information from online safely

PSHCE:

- To know it's important to share feelings and who is safe to share them with.
- Understand how to make informed decisions and understand their consequences
- Identify what harms our local environment and how to protect it
- To know what a healthy lifestyle is

RE:

- Think about friendship with God and to think about why forgiveness is important in a friendship
- Explain why Jesus' death helped mend friendships with God
- Explain why the resurrection of Jesus should be celebrated

Music:

- Learn to play simple pieces on a range of percussion instruments

Art:

- Design and create clay creatures
- Design our own formal garden
