Dear parents and carers,

Following their release earlier this week, I am delighted to be able to share with the school community the End of Key Stage 2 (Year 6) Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) 2022 results.

Year 6 children take tests in Reading, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling and Maths. These, alongside teacher assessments of English writing and science, provide vital information to parents about their child's attainment, support the transition to secondary schools and identify where additional support is best targeted to individuals.

Due to COVID-19, SATs were suspended for the last two years, however a full programme of tests took place this year.

We are thrilled to share the overall SATs results with the whole school community.
