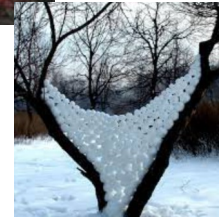

- Andy Goldsworthy is a living British sculptor who uses the environment to make art. He has an OBE from the Queen.
- In winter the trees and the weather are different compared to the other seasons
- There are important ways to stay safe in the winter months

English:

- Little Wandle Phase 5 phonics
- To write simple recounts from own experiences including season walks
- To use and apply pre and suffixes in writing and spoken language
- To retell narratives and write their own version of One Snowy Night by N. Butterworth

Geography

- Visit to Claremont Fancourt School to find signs of winter
- To recognise physical changes in the seasons during the winter months eg trees/ climate/ weather

Art:

- To use finger painting to re-create an AG sculpture
- To photograph their own sculptures and create a frame using leaf prints
- To create their own sculpture using nature
- To make a winter 3D collage using magazines

Science:

- Seasonal changes around the world and how the changes in weather affects us
- How to keep our bodies safe in winter

Maths:

- Addition and subtraction
- Fact Families
- Subtraction and addition on a number-line
- Adding and subtracting 1 or 2
- Counting forwards and backwards to 20
- Write numbers in numerals to 20
- Numbers from 11-20
- Place Value: Tens and Ones

- How do Jewish people celebrate Shabbat?
- What is the Torah and why is it important to Jews?

Computing:

- Online Safety. How can Digi Duck help us to stay safe online. What do we do if we see something that worries us?

- To explore existing Andy Goldsworthy Sculpture
- To design and make their own sculpture using the environment
- To evaluate their sculptures and consider ways of changing them

- Looking after our planet and our community. What can we do to make a difference?
