Expert knowledge:

- In the Neolithic era, people began to live in groups known as communities. Skara Brae is an example of this
- During the Iron Age, people began to live in community groups called tribes led by a king or chief. Tribes usually lived around hill forts.
- Goods like bronze and copper were traded for other items and this was called bartering
- Archaeologists are historians who learn about the past by recovering buildings, graves and other objects from the past
- The Amesbury Archer was one of the most significant historical discoveries in Europe and his grave is three miles from Stonehenge
